Behavioral Health

Convened the Behavioral Health Coalition comprised of over **20 community stakeholders** and worked collaboratively to coordinate mental health services.



COVID-19 Response

Partnered with Test Nebraska to ensure testing access in Colfax County and hosted **20 clinics** to administer over **4,700 vaccines** to community members.



Social Determinants of Health

Distributed **4,500 farmers market vouchers** throughout the community to provide healthy food to families.
